WHEREAS, the Cherokee Nation, has one (1) flat screen monitor for a computer, three (3) hard drives, five (5) wireless keyboards and five (5) wireless mICE that are surplus to the needs of Cherokee Nation Information Systems and,

WHEREAS, the Claremore Veterans Center, in Claremore, Oklahoma, provides 24-hour medical and nursing care for veterans, many of whom are Cherokee citizens.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHEROKEE NATION, that the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, Chadwick Smith, and/or his authorized designee(s) be authorized to execute the donation of one (1) flat screen monitor for a computer, three (3) hard drives, five (5) wireless keyboards and five (5) wireless mice to the Claremore Veterans Center, in Claremore, Oklahoma.
