WHEREAS, Jose Acala, is a bicycle mechanic and he diligently volunteers each year during the Remember the Removal Bike ride, and.

WHEREAS, the participants of the Remember the Removal Bike ride are grateful for his service, ensuring their safety during the more than 1,000-mile bike ride, and
