

WHEREAS, the office of the Principal Chief and the Council of the Cherokee Nation desire to recognize, commemorate, and celebrate 150 years of history, legacy, and achievements of Sequoyah Schools; and

WHEREAS, nothing herein constitutes an appropriation of funds, precludes Council's constitutional role of oversight and appropriation of funds and all subjects herein are expressly subject to Council budget appropriation and oversight;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CHEROKEE NATION that the Council of the Cherokee Nation supports an investment of a minimum of \$20 million capital investment at Sequoyah Schools, subject to the normal appropriations process, with a capital plan or plan(s) to be submitted to the Council for review by its Education Committee within fiscal year 2022, to ensure that Sequoyah Schools continues in its mission of providing an educational institution that promotes personal and cultural development for another 150 years.
